King Asa

Introduction: Asa is noted as a man who was fully devoted to the Lord.

Opener: Who do you know that you would characterize as fully devoted to the Lord? What is it about them that stands out?

Key Scripture: 2 Chronicles 14-16

Discussion Questions:

- 1.) Read our church's mission statement: *NorthStar Church exists to bring Glory to God by leading people to become fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ.* What does a fully devoted follower of Jesus look like to you? What character traits do they possess? What attitudes do they have?
- 2.) Consider all the religious reforms Asa made. Destroying and removing things that people are emotionally attached to takes extraordinary courage. What did you learn from Asa's life about leadership?
- 3.) Read 2 Chronicles 14:6-7. What can we learn from these verses about following the Lord's ways?
- 4.) Read 2 Chronicles 15:16. It's hard to remove negative influencers that we have close relationships with from our life. Especially family and close friends. Why? What happens if we don't?
- 5.) Read 2 Chronicles 15:17 and 2 Chronicles 21:4-6. How are they connected?
- 6.) We have a tendency to be Self Sufficient when we need to be Savior Dependent. When we are Savior Dependent we become Spirit Dominated. What does it look like to be fully surrendered to the Spirit of God in our lives? What happens when I try to be King of my own life?
