Defining Moments: The Resurrection

1 Corinthians 15:13-22

Main Idea

God uses defining moments in our lives to shape us into who he wants us to be. These are the moments that God weaves together to write the story of our lives.

Study

Defining moments can come from deep emotional pain, a piercing truth, or a deep love or longing for God. How has God used a defining moment in your life to change you?

In his sermon, Scott gave two main reasons that the most important defining moment in the course of human history was the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead:

1. Without it, Christianity would not exist.
2. It is what sets us apart from every other belief system in World History.

Briefly discuss these two points within your group. Do you agree? Why or why not?

Scott then went on to explain that the Resurrection changes our past, our present, and our future. The following are the scripture references from the sermon. Read each one within your group and discuss the changes the Resurrection brought about.

1. It changes our Past – Ephesians 2:1-5
2. It changes our Present – 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14
3. It changes our Future – 1 Corinthians 15:50-58
