Bible Story: **Crossing The Jordan River**: Joshua 3:10–4:9  
Memory Verse: 1 Samuel 12:24

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## Family Discussion Questions

Why did the Israelites build an altar after crossing the Jordan River?

Why were there twelve stones?

Can you remember other times in the Bible where God's people were told to remember what God had done?

Read Joshua 4:6b-7. Imagine one of the kids in the Bible story had asked you, "What do these stones mean?" How would you explain it to them?

Do you or your family have things you do to remember events that have happened before?

What are some things we do at church to remind us of things God has done?

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## ACTIVITY I Story Stones

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Give each kid a medium-sized smooth stone and permanent marker. Invite them to write a word or draw a picture or symbol to remind them of something God has done for them. Encourage them to carry the stone with them as a reminder.

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## Memory Verse

Time to get God's word deep in our hearts. We believe memorizing scripture is so important to knowing his ways and having wisdom for everyday situations. Take a few minutes to go over the memory verse together!
