Family Discussion Questions

Why was God not pleased with the Israelites at the time when Gideon lived? What did God tell Gideon?

What did Gideon think about this? How did he react?

Read Judges 6:39-40. Have you ever asked God for a sign?

If you were Gideon, would you have reacted the same way, needing reassurance that you heard God correctly?

Why do you think God chose Gideon to free the Israelites?

How do you think it makes God feel when we don't trust God?

ACTIVITY | What Brings Us Peace?

INSTRUCTIONS: *Take a large piece of poster board and divide it in half down the center (use a marker). Give each kid one sticky note and have them write things that give them peace (and comfort), then put it up on the "people" side of the board. Then after discussing with the kids, have them write one way God gives them peace, and put that on the "God" side of the board.*

Memory Verse
